- 2. The In-Office Procedure: The Rinsada procedure is quick, comfortable, and typically takes about 10-15 minutes.
- You will be comfortably seated in our exam chair.
- Your eye doctor will use a specialized, single-use Rinsada device.
- A controlled, gentle stream of sterile saline solution is applied to the surface of your eye and, most importantly, underneath your eyelids, in the deep folds called the "fornix." These are areas that are difficult to clean with regular eye drops or at-home rinses.
- The device is designed with a soft curve and multiple micro-ports to ensure a thorough and even rinse, removing debris and inflammatory agents from the entire ocular surface.
- You may feel a cool, refreshing sensation. Most patients experience no discomfort during the procedure.
- 3. Immediate Relief: Following the rinse, any excess fluid is gently wiped away. Many patients report an immediate feeling of relief, with their eyes feeling less irritated, less gritty, and more comfortable.
- 4. Aftercare & Ongoing Treatment:
- There is typically no downtime, and you can resume your normal activities right away.
