- 3. Deep-Cleaning: Your doctor will gently cleanse your eyelids and lashes with the Zocukit, carefully scrubbing along the base of your eyelashes. This process is similar to a facial scrub and feels relaxing.
- 4. Rinsing: After the deep-cleaning, the Zest gel is rinsed away with a sterile saline solution. Your eyes may feel refreshed and noticeably cleaner immediately.
- 5. Post-Treatment Care: Your optometrist will provide you with at-home care instructions to maintain the results of your treatment. This may include using Zocular eyelid wipes or cleansers.
